Christian Counseling Centers of Utah, formerly known as Shepherd's Staff Christian Counseling Center, is a non-profit organization [501(c)3] providing professional services from an interdenominational Christian perspective. We believe that traditional counseling and psychotherapy or life coaching services are more effective when they are applied and understood from a perspective sensitive to one's faith and spiritual commitment. We believe that human experience, whether troublesome or fulfilling, has spiritual as well as social, psychological, and physical components

We are confident that the compassionate, healing ministry of Jesus Christ continues today by the work of the Holy Spirit through His believers. We combine up-to-date professional practice and the creative application of Biblical principles to our client's unique circumstances.

Though we provide services from a Christian perspective we do not

proselytize and welcome and respect those from other faiths as well as those who have no religious affiliation. We provide individual treatment, family therapy, child and adolescent therapy, marital and couples counseling and group therapy.
