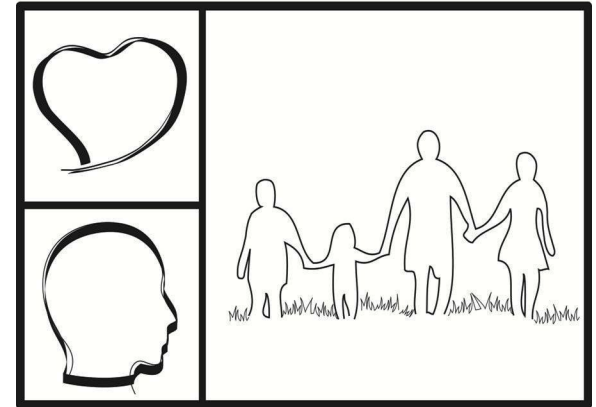

We also provide seminars, workshops, critical incident stress management, interventions for organizations, and supervision and consultation for pastors and other professionals .
